RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All entries must be present at the judging area no later than 9:00 am.
2. Those not in their respective judging area will not be judged.
3. Remain in judging area until Official asks you to move into parade line-up position. Failing to do this will result in your entry being put at the end of the parade.
4. **ZERO TOLERANCE** for any verbal and/or physical abuse towards any Parade Volunteers or Participants. Parade Marshall and/or Parade Officials will ask your entry to leave the parade.
5. **NO MATERIAL/CANDY MAY BE THROWN FROM ANY MOVING VEHICLE – WALKING MEMBERS OF YOUR ENTRY MAY HAND OUT TO THE CROWD.**
6. No Water Guns, Water Balloons, Silly String is allowed to be used towards participants or spectators.
7. All family pets must be leashed at all times.
8. All vehicles must adhere to Alberta Highway Safety Act (must be licensed and have liability insurance). (Spot checks will be made and entry refused to participate)
9. All entries must provide driver with visibility and control.
10. No consumption of alcohol or drugs will be tolerated before, during or after the parade.
11. Proper safety equipment must be used for any moving equipment.
12. For your own protection, please contact your insurance for your parade entry.
13. Leave a minimum of 15' between you and the entry in front of you so everyone can view your entry.
14. The Town of Redcliff assumes no responsibility in connection with, and makes no representation as to the safety of any parade entry, in whole or in part, solely By Compliance with the Parade Rules and Regulations.
15. The Town of Redcliff will not be responsible for any damage to persons or property before, during and after the parade.

CATEGORIES

Prizes to be announced!

CLASS 1: COMMERCIAL

Entries include Business and Companies whose main activity is for profit, such as retail, industrial, profession, trade provider of goods and services.

CLASS 2: NON-COMMERCIAL

Entries include non-profit organizations Operated by elected officials, cultural/ethics Groups, church organizations, groups supporting youth or seniors.

CLASS 3: ANTIQUE, CLASSIC, MODIFIED VEHICLES

Includes cars, trucks, vintage, farm equipment, must be in running order.

CLASS 4: WESTERN

Includes any livestock, horse drawn equipment, buggies, chuckwagons, glamour costume horse and rider.

CLASS 5: COMEDY & INDIVIDUAL

Entry represents a person or group, but groups will be judged as a single entry. Can be comedic in nature and not considered a business or non-profit organization (e.g. Mascots, Singers, Clowns, Entertainers, modified vehicles that are not considered antiques would fit in this category).

CLASS 6: KIDS (Under 14 years of age)

This entry is for any child and their use of various items to decorate their bikes, wagons, family pet, use of skateboards, rollerblades etc. They must however be able to keep the pace of the parade.
