PHOTO CONTEST RULES



Overview

The Town of Redcliff is looking for a photo to be on the cover of its new **Municipal Development Plan**, or MDP. The MDP is the document that guides how the Town will grow and develop in the future.

We want **YOUR** vision of Redcliff to be captured in the MDP. **We are looking for photos that best represent what it means to live in Redcliff to be featured in the plan.** This could be a photo of the natural environment, buildings, people, special events, landmarks, or anything you feel encapsulates Redcliff in an image.

Eligibility

All Canadian residents are eligible to enter the photo contest.

Town of Redcliff employees, members of Redcliff Town Council, and Redcliff MDP Steering Committee members may enter the photo contest to have their photos used in the Municipal Development Plan, but are ineligible to win prizes.

There is no age limit for contest entrants. Contest entrants under 18 must receive parent/guardian authorization on their entry form.

The maximum number of entries per person is 5. Each photo entry must be accompanied by a separate entry form.

Contest Duration

The contest opens on May 15th, 2018 at 12:00am and closes on June 15th, 2018 at 11:59pm.

Any photos submitted outside of the above listed dates and times will be disqualified.

Prizes

1st Prize: photo featured on front cover of the MDP and Town of Redcliff prize pack

2nd Prize: photo featured on vision section cover page of the MDP and Town of Redcliff prize pack

3rd Prize: photo featured on goals section cover page of the MDP and Town of Redcliff prize pack

Submitting a Photo

Complete and submit the entry form, found at www.redcliff.ca/news/ along with your photo in one of the following ways:

1. Email

- a) download the entry form
- b) fill out the entry form on your computer or mobile device

- c) save the completed entry form
- d) email the completed entry form and your photo to: jordanz@redcliff.ca

****NOTE:** photo size cannot exceed 10MB, photos must be in JPG or PNG format

2. In Person

- a) print off the entry form
- b) fill out the entry form by hand
- c) bring the completed entry form AND a copy of your photo on a USB, CD, or DVD to the Planning & Engineering Department in Redcliff Town Hall at #1 – 3rd Street NE

****NOTE:** photo size cannot exceed 10MB, photos must be in JPG or PNG format

****NOTE:** if entering in person, you can also fill out an entry form at Town Hall.

Entry Requirements

1. Each entry form must be completed in full.
2. Each photo must be taken principally in and of Redcliff, Alberta.
3. There are no restrictions on the date the photo was taken.
4. Each photo must be an original photo taken by the artist whose name is on the entry form.
5. No entries will be accepted before the contest opening date, or after the contest closing date.
6. Photos that depict, include, or suggest offensive or inappropriate content will be disqualified.
7. All photo entries must be submitted digitally in either JPG or PNG format. The maximum file size per photo is 10MB.
8. Photos may be enhanced by the entrant; however, highly manipulated photos to the point where the photo appears unrealistic may result in the entry being disqualified.
9. The entrant represents and warrants that they have obtained all necessary rights regarding the photo to enter the contest. This includes, but is not limited to, the consent of any persons or parties whose image or property is depicted in the photo.
10. Entry photos must not infringe on any copyrights, trademarks, rights of privacy/publicity or intellectual property rights. If requested by the Town of Redcliff, the entrant must provide written documentation indicating consent/release by legal holder(s) of applicable copyrights, trademarks, rights of privacy/publicity or intellectual property rights. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.

Entry Conditions

By submitting a photo to the contest, entrants agree and consent to:

1. Be bound by the official contest rules described in this document;
2. The possible use, editing, modification, and reproduction of his/her photo, whether prize winner or not, by the Town of Redcliff for the MDP, Town of Redcliff website, or any other future media purposes by the Town, with the exception of sale and redistribution, with credit given to the artist, without notification or compensation;
3. The use of their provided information for the sole purpose of administering the contest (i.e. contacting potential winners);

4. Waive all claims of moral rights in any use of their submitted photos by the Town of Redcliff, pursuant to the rights granted in these Official Rules;
5. Release and forever discharge the Town of Redcliff, and agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Town of Redcliff from and against any and all claims, damages or liability, including any costs or losses related to personal injury, death, damage to or loss or destruction of property, arising out of, or in any way related to, (a) their participation in the contest, (b) the awarding, receipt, possession, use or misuse of any prize, in whole or in part, or any travel or activity related to any prize, (c) the use of any photo entered in accordance with the rights granted in these rules, or (d) any breach of these rules.

Judging

The winning photo will be chosen by the Municipal Development Plan Steering Committee. Photo entries will be judged on the following criteria:

1. Image Quality
2. Image Originality & Uniqueness
3. How Well the Image Portrays Life in Redcliff

The winners will be chosen in mid-June and notified by the Town of Redcliff by the end of June. Failure of a potential winner to respond to notification by the Town of Redcliff may result in choosing an alternative winner. The decision of the Steering Committee is final.

Disqualification

Entrants who do not comply with the rules contained in this document are subject to disqualification.

Privacy

The Town of Redcliff will handle entrant information in accordance with Town of Redcliff privacy policies. Entrants consent to the Town of Redcliff's use of their personal information to administer the photo contest by submitting personal information to enter the photo contest. Information provided by entrants is personal information as defined in the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, R.S.A. 2000 C F-25, as amended, and is collected pursuant to section 33(C) of the Act.

Cancellation

If at any time or for any reason the Town of Redcliff deems the contest cannot run as originally intended, the Town of Redcliff may cancel, modify, or suspend the contest or change the official rules.

Liability

The Town of Redcliff does not assume liability for: stolen, late, incomplete, illegible, inaccurate, or undelivered communications or entries; entry errors, omissions, or interruptions; failures, malfunctions, and difficulties with computer systems, networks, or website connections; printing, typographical, or other errors, including incorrect or inaccurate information appearing within contest-related materials; injury or damage to any computer or device resulting from or otherwise related to participation in the contest, the use of any website, or the downloading or accessing of any materials; anyone being incorrectly or mistakenly identified as a winner or potential winner; or any other errors, problems or difficulties of any kind, whether human, mechanical, electronic, or otherwise, including errors, problems or difficulties related to administration, advertising, entry processing, cancellation or prize announcements and distribution of the photo contest.
