Volunteer Fire Fighter(s)

Position Summary:

The Volunteer Firefighter is responsible for firefighting, rescue, medical assist services and other related fire and life safety services. They assist in the delivery programs for the prevention of fires, saving of life and property and public safety education. The Firefighter is responsible for rapidly, efficiently and safely performing various duties under emergency conditions frequently involving considerable hazard. The work includes routine duties in the maintenance of firefighting vehicles, equipment and fire department facilities as assigned. The personal rewards and satisfaction received from the fire and rescue service are often beyond description. Accomplishment, compassion and fulfillment are only a few of the words firefighters use to describe their feelings about their position.

Core Accountabilities:

- Respond to emergency calls immediately and as directed. Perform a variety of rescue related duties to protect the public and lessen severity of injuries.
- Drive and/or operate any vehicle or piece of equipment as assigned.
- Maintain an adequate level of physical fitness to continuously perform all required duties including, but not limited to, excellent cardiovascular fitness and capacity to bend, lift, and carry as required.
- Regularly attend scheduled training sessions. Demonstrate an ongoing commitment to lifelong learning in the areas of fire suppression, incident response and personal development.
- Endeavour to build a positive team atmosphere at the Fire Station and between stations and foster positive relationships with internal and external customers
- Aid in the maintenance of firefighting and medical equipment, tools, and apparatus to ensure readiness for any emergency service response.
- Participate in community related projects as directed.

Requirements:

- A Canadian Class 5 Drivers License (minimum)

- Minimum 18 years of age
- Ability to understand and communicate in English (written and oral)
- Possess the ability and stamina sufficient to perform all functions of this position in extremely adverse conditions.
- Able to commit to training and respond to emergency calls
- Live and/or work in the response area
- No conviction of a criminal offense related to the job duties of a firefighter

Responsibilities:

- Work as part of a team to respond to emergency situations
- Ability to react quickly and remain calm in stressful situations.

Responsibilities:

- Work as part of a team to respond to emergency situations.
- Protect citizens in times of crisis.
- Perform the duties of emergency responder, fire suppression, and public education as assigned.
- Learn the skills of an emergency responder.
- Respond to a broad range of emergency situations.
- Provide pre-hospital care for victims.
- Be a community role model.
- Responsible for upgrading and maintaining skills/knowledge and physical requirements.
- Maintain fire station and the upkeep of firefighting equipment.
